(some would call this a type of vision but it isn't - it is just no longer being blind to reality; the unseen reality of demons and angels all around us http://biblehub.com/1\_corinthians/12-10.htm) there are open visions similar to "remote viewing" in which you can see plainly like a window opening in front of your eyes something that is happening elsewhere: http://biblehub.com/john/1-48.htm then there are open visions that symbolize events or real things (seeing imagery while awake of Divine Revelations about real events in the material world) http://biblehub.com/daniel/7-13.htm such Divine Revelations are commonly called visions while you awake whether they occur in daylight or at night. http://biblehub.com/daniel/4-13.htm and http://biblehub.com/daniel/8-2.htm (and the Book of Revelation as a whole) While resting or sleeping, Divine Revelations come to those filled with the Holy Ghost in the form of dreams (these vivid dreams solidify the Truth declared in God's Word but can be about specific events, warnings, or teachings from God to give us understanding about things he wishes us to know) - http://biblehub.com/matthew/2-12.htm In these ways God has taught me many things over the years, even about how to discern dreams and visions (try the spirits - http://biblehub.com/1 john/4-1.htm) If you are in a dream and you control the dream (can control what you do in the dream and can even change the imagery at will) that is your own imagination or dream (same with visions), if you have a dream or vision that you are being shown something that is CONTRARY to the Word of GOD, sows to pride, deception or any vice, that is a vision or dream from the spirit of error (fantasy, fiction), but IF you are shown a dream or vision that is FUNDAMENTALLY TRUE, Glorifies GOD is factually true about things past, present or future that is from the Holy Spirit! http://biblehub.com/john/16-13.htm There are dreams and visions that will show you actual physical things and real people and there are dreams and visions that show images that refer to actual events and truth about the seen and unseen creation of GOD. <u>http://biblehub.com/genesis/41-</u> 5.htm God can obviously even give such messages to those who have not received His Spirit, but for those who have, I have found personally (in my case) that I received constant dreams and visions from our Creator ever since I was anointed (for the first seven years daily - many thousands upon thousands of dreams and visions from God to give me His Understanding of all things according to His Promise http://biblehub.com/john/14-26.htm I find too many these days mocking such things (attributing dreams and visions to something they ate or laughing at or about anyone learning from God in these Divinely promised ways; sadly, they are fulfilling: http://biblehub.com/2 timothy/3-5.htm

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Jeremiah Ellis I understand your concept about there being nothing impossible for God, and agree. But I also agree that God does not change, and God is not the author of confusion. Joseph had two dreams. Pharoah had two dreams. Nebukadnezzar had two dreams. Can you see a pattern? I believe the Bible is the word of God. He established the two-dream precedent with Joseph to reveal to us that biblucally-recorded dreams are divinely given when they come in twos.

Visions are another story. They don't come in twos. In the fall of 2000, I had two dreams. They were both about the same thing. At the time, I thought they were very strange. I hadn't discovered Joseph's

dream precedent yet. I went on a trip from New Mexico to Pennsylvania to see my father's wife right before she passed. On the way home, God gave me a vision of 9/11. When I arrived home in Albuquerque, I told my wife about the vision. She immediately said the things that she said in my two dreams, which confirmed that what I saw was a real vision and not just my imagination.

I am not saying that God can't give someone divine revelation in "a" dream. I just don't believe He would establish a precedent and then change. The type of dream may be important. All the biblical dream pairs are prophetic in nature. And my two dreams were prophetic in nature.

And its quite possible that some who have prophetic dreams either don't recall dreaming twice, or don't relate that info.

But in the case of King Nebukadnezzar, I believe its necessary to follow Joseph's dream precedent to truly understand the meanings of his dreams.

In addition, He can send MORE than just two dreams or visions on a topic (the Book of Revelation is a prime example it says the same things over and over and over again to show it is certainly fixed and true from our Creator).
